Dear Interested Party:

Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install application submitted by AK Steel Dearborn Works (AK Steel), to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), requesting the addition of an electrostatic oiling process at the facility located at 4001 Miller Road, Dearborn, Michigan.

AK Steel has withdrawn the permit application which was previously published for comment in January, 2016, as Draft Permit to Install No. 8-08B. Therefore, a public hearing will NOT be held on this application.

AK Steel re-evaluated the need for the electrostatic oiling process and has decided not to install it. Also, the company has determined that a volatile organic compound (VOC) emission increase is not needed. AK Steel will continue to meet the established emission limits as verified by emissions testing and monitoring requirements in the current permits for the facility. The recordkeeping and updated emission calculation procedures for VOC emissions will be done using United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Test Method 24 of 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A.
