League releases statement on certification of November election results

Lansing, MI – The **League of Women Voters of Michigan** today issued the following statement following the Michigan Board of State Canvassers' vote to certify the results of the November election during its meeting today.

The Board of State Canvassers has the legal responsibility to certify election results as multiple bipartisan election experts stated last week during a [press conference](#) sponsored by the League.

"The Board of State Canvassers' job is simple: meet and certify the election results. As a result, despite attacks on the process, the voices of Michigan voters were heard today," said **Christina Schlitt**, president of the League of Women Voters of Michigan. "For over 100 years, the League has been working to empower voters to participate in our democracy. We applaud the Board's decision to certify the election results because it reflects the will of the people. The voters did their duty by voting in record numbers in this election, and the Board completed its job as it should."
