LWVUS Program Planning is now in effect for the LWVUS 2024 Convention in Washington DC details.

LWVMI paid out \$43,550 in grant money to local Leagues last week! This money was for the Town Hall Grants and the Election Promotion Grant.

Yes! We will be awarding grant money to Leagues doing 2024 Town Hall meetings about the new voting rights because guess what? There are plenty of people who still need to learn about these wonderful new rights (that all take effect on February 13, 2024.)
