A repeal of PA 1 would decrease the minimum wage from \$13.73 to \$13.29 (2026) and from \$15 to \$14.16 (2027), with annual inflation-based increases thereafter; increase tipped worker wage to 48 percent of the full minimum wage in 2025, 60 percent in 2026, 70 percent in 2027, 80 percent in 2028, 90 percent in 2029 and 100 percent in 2030; and eliminate civil fines for employers failing to pay minimum hourly wage.
